Compare an ocean with a lake and a sea with a river.

Design an underwater resort of the future. Create a travel brochure to describe it in detail.

Draw a picture of a rock pool with the marine life that live there.

Compose a song or dance which shows the actions and movements of different molluscs, crustaceans, echinoderms, anemones and coelenterates .

Explain how oil spills, sewerage, pesticides and dumping of toxic wastes contributes to the death of ocean life.

If you could talk with a deep sea diver, what would you want to ask about marine life he or she has seen in underwater explorations.
